### How to Use 1000+™ Stain Remover

With over a thousand uses in one convenient solution you will have many ways in which to benefit from 1000+ Stain Remover. Use full strength for stains or dilute with water for superior spray cleaning.

**Precaution:** Use only on a surface that is water-safe (most surfaces). Paper, uncoated wood and sensitive wool are

**1000+ Stain Remover is very kind to skin.** You can use your hands in the cleaning process wherever you feel comfortable doing so. No gloves are required for normal skin, which means that you can work with 1000+ Stain Remover in many ways.

**1000+ Stain Remover can be used full strength or diluted.** As a stain remover, apply directly to stain, and allow to soak in. Rub with wet cloth, scouring sponge or fingers. Add water, rub more. Rinse well with water and blot with dry or damp cloth to complete. Repeat if necessary. For general cleaning, mix 1 part 1000+ to 10 parts or more of water in a reusable trigger spray bottle or squirt some in a bucket.

A towel and scouring sponge will often be the only tools you will need to rub or wipe the stains or messes.

Making the sponge or towel wet is important because 1000+ Stain Remover works best with water.

## **PAINT MESSSES**

---

Latex, oil or spray - paint messes have never been so easy to clean-up, which is why 1000+ Stain Remover is a painter's best friend!

### **CARPET, UPHOLSTERY AND FLOORS**

STEP 1: Apply just enough 1000+ Stain Remover to moisten the stain

STEP 2: Rub with fingertips to loosen the stain from the material being cleaned (until you can see the stain has mixed with the product)

STEP 3: Wipe or dab carpet to remove product and stain

STEP 4\*: **Spray liberally with water – ideally from a spray bottle with a jet stream (better than a mist or pouring it on)**

STEP 5: Gently dab away the water and stain with a clean cloth

STEP 6: Repeat steps 4 and 5, if necessary

TIP: For quicker results, use a carpet cleaner filled with plain water in place of steps 3 and 4.

### **ON SKIN (ALSO FOR MARKERS OR INK)**

STEP 1: Apply just enough 1000+ Stain Remover to moisten the stain

STEP 2: Rub with fingertips to dissolve

STEP 3: Rinse under running water or with a damp cloth

### **PAINT BRUSHES (STILL WET)**

STEP 1: Apply just enough 1000+ Stain Remover to moisten the brush/roller

STEP 2: Rub with fingertips to loosen the paint (until the paint has mixed with the product)

STEP 3: Rinse thoroughly with water

STEP 4: Dry with a clean cloth

### **PAINT BRUSHES (DRIED)**

STEP 1: In a glass jar, put enough 1000+ Stain Remover to cover the bristles

STEP 2: Allow to soak overnight

STEP 3: Rinse thoroughly with water

STEP 4: Dry with a clean cloth

STEP 5: Repeat steps 3 and 4, if necessary

- This is the KEY STEP (as water is 1000+ Stain Remover's best friend) where you should see the water instantly penetrate the stain and clean the surface that had the stain on it.

## **STAINS**

---

Wine stains, fruit juices, blood, nail polish, lipstick, shoe polish and grease (to name a few) can be removed safely and easily.

### **CARPET, UPHOLSTERY AND FLOORS**

STEP 1: Apply just enough 1000+ Stain Remover to moisten the stain

STEP 2: Rub with fingertips to loosen the stain (until the stain has mixed with the product)

STEP 3\*: **Spray liberally with water – ideally from a spray bottle with a jet stream (better than a mist or pouring on it)**

STEP 4: Gently dab away the water and stain gently with a clean cloth

STEP 5: Repeat steps 3 and 4, if necessary

TIP: For quicker results, use a carpet cleaner filled with plain water in place of steps 3 and 4.

## **DRIED NAIL POLISH**

STEP 1: Apply just enough 1000+ Stain Remover to moisten the stain

STEP 2: Rub with scouring sponge or toothbrush to loosen the polish

STEP 3\*: **Spray liberally with water – ideally from a spray bottle with a jet stream (better than a mist or pouring on it)**

STEP 4: Gently dab away the water and stain with a clean cloth

STEP 5: Repeat steps 3 and 4, if necessary

- This is the KEY STEP (as water is 1000+ Stain Remover's best friend) where you should see the water instantly penetrate the stain and clean the surface that had the stain on it.

## **PET MESSSES**

---

Pet messes of all kinds are now easier to clean up than ever before.

### **CARPET, UPHOLSTERY AND PET BEDS**

STEP 1: Apply just enough 1000+ Stain Remover to moisten the stain

STEP 2: Rub with scouring sponge or brush to loosen the stain

STEP 3\*: **Spray liberally with water – ideally from a spray bottle with a jet stream (better than a mist or pouring on it)**

STEP 4: Gently dab away the water and stain with a clean cloth

STEP 5: Repeat steps 3 and 4, if necessary

- This is the KEY STEP (as water is 1000+ Stain Remover's best friend) where you should see the water instantly penetrate the stain and clean the surface that had the stain on it.

## **VEHICLE DETAILING**

---

Car, truck, boat or RV detailing inside and out can be done quickly and safely using 1000+ Stain Remover. (Please note that you should never clean your car in direct sunlight.)

### **CARPETS**

STEP 1: Apply just enough 1000+ Stain Remover to moisten the stain

STEP 2: Rub with fingertips to loosen the stain (until the stain has mixed with 1000+)

STEP 3\*: **Spray liberally with water – ideally from a spray bottle with a jet stream (better than a mist or pouring on it)**

STEP 4: Gently dab away the water and stain with a clean cloth

STEP 5: Repeat steps 3 and 4, if necessary

### **UPHOLSTERY**

STEP 1: Dilute 1 parts 1000+ Stain Remover with 4 parts water in a trigger spray bottle

STEP 2: Apply to upholstery

STEP 3: Rub with finger or brush to loosen the stain

STEP 4\*: **Spray liberally with water – ideally from a spray bottle with a jet stream (better than a mist or pouring on it)**

STEP 5: Gently dab away the water and stain with a clean cloth

STEP 6: Repeat steps 4 and 5, if necessary

### **TIRES AND RIMS**

STEP 1: Pour just enough 1000+ Stain Remover to make a light film directly on the tires/rims

STEP 2: Rub with non-abrasive scouring sponge or brush to loosen the dirt

STEP 3\*: **Rinse thoroughly with water.**

- This is the KEY STEP (as water is 1000+ Stain Remover's best friend) where you should see the water instantly penetrate the stain and clean the surface that had the stain on it.

## LAUNDRY

---

Use 1000+ Stain Remover to remove those stubborn stains and to brighten your colours.

### PRE-WASH STAIN REMOVAL

STEP 1: Apply a liberal amount of 1000+ Stain Remover to stain and rub gently

STEP 2: If stain is food, blood, grass or grease based, let soak for 10-15 minutes. If stain has been allowed to dry let soak for half an hour. If stain is paint, dye, wine/juice garment may require additional soaking.

STEP 3: Launder garment as usual

STEP 4: Repeat for stubborn stains, if necessary

**PLEASE NOTE:** Drying in the dryer will set the stain into the garment. Be sure to remove the entire stain before drying the garment.

### LAUNDRY BOOSTER

STEP 1: Add a squirt of 1000+ Stain Remover (for a full load)

STEP 2: Reduce detergent by half

STEP 3: Wash as usual

## GENERAL CLEANING

---

Household surfaces are quickly and simply cleaned with 1000+ Stain Remover.

### COUNTERS, CUPBOARDS, WALLS AND FLOORS

STEP 1: Dilute 1 part 1000+ Stain Remover to up to 10 parts or more water in a trigger spray bottle

STEP 2: Apply to surface

STEP 3: Wipe with cloth or paper towel

### SINKS, TUBS AND TOILETS

STEP 1: Squirt a small amount of 1000+ round the fixture

STEP 2: Rub with non-abrasive scouring sponge or brush to loosen the dirt / stain / mold

STEP 3: Rinse with water
